

# EDUCATION ABROAD SCHOLARSHIPS

## The Toshizo Watanabe Study Abroad Scholarships

- Covers full cost of program, but must demonstrate financial need
- Preference for applicants raised by a single parent or have lost both parents, first-generation, and those without international study experience

## Gilman and Gilman-McCain Scholarship

- Up to \$5k for Pell Grant recipients + \$3k if you are studying a Critical Need Language.
- Deadlines: Early March for Summer, Fall, and Academic Year + Early October for Spring + Early Summer

## Boren Scholarship

- Ideal candidate is studying an underrepresented language and culture AND for an academic year program
- Within 3 years of graduation, recipient must work for 1 year for the Department of Defense, Homeland Security, State, or Intelligence Community

## Rotary International Grants

- Grants ranging from \$12,000-26,000 for students abroad at a minimum of 3 months

## Golden Key Grants

- Grants up to \$5,000 for Golden Key members
- Based on academic merit and relevance of education abroad trip to field of study

## Fund for Education Abroad Scholarships

- Up to \$10k. One app is considered for multiple opportunities, including LGBTQIA+
- Preference given to programs that include language or substantial service-learning components AND non-traditional destinations.
